Good Evening Everyone, thank you all for joining our Annual AGM tonight.

I won't list the individual items that make up the accounts however if you would like a copy please do let me know and we can circulate after the AGM.

Through the various events that were held this year such as break the rules day, Christmas gift shop and raffle, sponsored read and school fete. The Infants raised £3,293.81 and the Juniors raised £1932.31.

Throughout the year donations were requested by both schools for various events such as coaches for school trips, Christmas crackers and hoodies and ice creams for the year 6 leavers. The infant school donations totals £3,251.56 and the Junior school £985.19. These expenditure figures also include any payments made for external fund raising items such as mothers day gifts.
