

### **Year 6 swimming proficiency 2022-3**

In total, we have 104 children in Year 6. Parents were asked to respond to a survey and there have been 39 responses.

The National Curriculum sets out the expectation that by the end of KS2, children should be able to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres;
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke];
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

From the responses received, the number of Year 6 children who can not meet the end of key stage 2 swimming requirements is 35.
